Born in Bruck/Mur (A), Prof. Fürstner studied chemistry at the TU Graz. After postdoctoral research in the group of the late Prof. Oppolzer (Geneva, CH) he obtained his habilitation from the TU Graz in 1992 and then moved to the Max-Planck Institut für Kohlenforschung, where he soon became Director.

Prof. Fürstner is most famous for his seminal contributions in the fields of organometallic chemistry and natural product synthesis, and we look forward to a series of fascinating and entertaining lectures.
