

How to find School on Gravity and Light

Taking place at the Johannes Kepler University from Mon, Feb. 2nd to Sun, March 1st.

Arriving by plane



From Monday to Saturday take the bus shuttle into the city of Linz and go to the main railway station. But this bus is not in operation on Sunday. In that case you have to take a free shuttle service with small bus or van to the small railway station at Hösrsching and from there a train to the main railway station in Linz.

Arriving by train or bus from the airport

At the main railway station take the tram lines 1 or 2 in direction "Universität". For the school at the Johannes Kepler university leave the tram at the final station, whereas for the student house "Julius Raab Heim" leave the tram one stop earlier at "Schumpeterstrasse". Find these locations and the connection path in red color on the map below.

Arrival by car

Coming from Freeway A1 take exit Linz; follow Freeway A7 (Mühlkreisautobahn) in direction Freistadt/Praha passing the City of Linz; take exit Dornach (2nd exit after crossing the River Danube). Then, at the first road crossing go straight ahead for the university or turn to the right for the student residence "Julius Raab Heim". The directions are marked by green arrows in the map below.
