Pre-semester programme:

JKU offers an **Intensive German Language Course** prior to the beginning of each semester (beginner, lower intermediate and advanced levels). The course is **free of charge**.

For participants of the Intensive German Language Course, the arrival is obligatory before the course starts. The last day of arrival for all other exchange students is September 14, 2014 (tbc) in winter semester and February 8, 2015 (tbc) in summer semester in order to be able to register for courses.

Students are also highly recommended to participate in our pre-semester programme which consists of the "Orientation Session" at the International Office, a campus tour, a city tour and several excursions. The "Cultural Sensitivity Training" also forms part of the pre-semester programme.

Courses:

The language of instruction at JKU is mainly German. However, the university offers more than 300 courses in English every semester. A list of courses taught in English during the academic year 2013/14 is available on <http://www.jku.at/exchange/courses> as a reference.

JKU requires a minimum workload of 20 ECTS credits per semester.

Language requirement:

Level B2 (according to the [Common European Framework of Reference for Languages](#)) in either English or German is required. EXCEPTION: For the Master's programmes General Management and Applied Economics a minimum English level of C1 is obligatory!

Accommodation:

We provide accommodation for incoming students in one of the residence halls around the university or in the centre of Linz. The housing form is available on our homepage. The housing deadline is the same as the application deadline (June 1 and November 15 respectively). The prices for a single room are between ~ € 220 and € 380, for a place in a double room the price is between ~ € 170 and € 240.

Average living expenses:

€ 600 – € 750, depending on the different rates for a double or a single room.

Visa:

Students receive the necessary supporting documents (Letter of acceptance, Confirmation of accommodation) to apply for a visa or a residence permit. For students studying at JKU for a full academic year it is recommended to apply for the residence permit at least 12 weeks before the planned departure date.
