

## Cross Cultural Management for Engineers (247.013)

Department of International Management Summer Term 2024

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Workshop, 2.00 hours, 3.00 ECTS credits

## **Course Objectives**

The goal of this seminar is to sensitize students on cultural awareness in business life. In this course, the students will be confronted with issues and challenges in professional cross-cultural encounters, such as interactions between managers and subordinates, between business partners with diverse backgrounds, in multicultural project teams, or with a diverse workforce. Since culture-awareness requires mindset-work and self-reflection, the students will be predominantly dealing with tasks aiming on reflection and transfer mode.

The **aim** is to create the fundament for acquiring the following **skills**:

- Behaving culturally adequate in work with different cultures
- Communicate culturally sensitive in business meetings or business trips
- Self-reflection of own mindset in order to develop a global citizen attitude

In order to reach this aim, the below-listed subjects will be addressed:

- The concept of culture and diversity
- Cultural differences
- Intercultural interactions, communication and collaboration
- Migration and cultural integration

#### **Course Content and Structure**

The course content is defined as theory-led practical. The following learning-modes are applied:

- Blended Learning
- Open discussions on reflection and transfer tasks
- Group work and group development tasks

#### Course Dates and Mode

- The course will be held in presence. In case that the course needs to be switched to online-mode due to force majeure, students will be informed timely. Hybrid mode is precluded.
- The seminar language is in English.
- Attendance is expected for all class sessions. Students who attend less than 80% of the total class time will automatically receive a negative course grade. If students have scheduling conflicts, the lecturer needs to be informed at least 1 day in advance. Absences, which are not communicated to the lecturer, will not be excused.
