## The applicant hereby declares,

- 1. not to use the facilities of the PC laboratory (incl. Linux server) for non-university purposes<sup>1</sup> without the explicit consent of the Institute for Theoretical Physics (Prof. Ernst, Prof. Kramer, Prof. Renger).
- 2. not to install any programs on the computers.
- 3. to follow the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.
- 4. not to make his/her login credentials available to other persons.
- 5. not to allow any other persons access to the PC lab and, if necessary, to lock the PC lab.
- 6. not to process any data containing illegal content.

Failure to comply with the above points may result in legal and financial consequences for the applicant. In any case, the login credentials will be revoked.
