## Introduction

For a consistent appearance, kindly adhere to the following format when submitting your abstract. The standard text should be in *Times New Roman* font, size 10pt, and headings in bold *Arial* font, also size 10pt. Use single-line spacing and insert a blank line between paragraphs to enhance readability. **The abstract should be presented in a two-column format and should not exceed one page on an A4 size paper.**

In the text, references should be denoted by [reference numbers] and numbered in a consecutive sequence based on the order in which they are mentioned. Each reference should have its own unique number.

Abstracts should contain the following sections:

- Introduction
- Results and Discussion
- Conclusion
- References
- Acknowledgements.

## Results and Discussion

The results may consist of standard text, mathematical equations, tables, and figures. It is recommended to use an equation editor to insert equations, entered in 10 point font size:

$$I_{\sim} = i \omega \frac{\eta j_{\sim} A}{\kappa k d} \int_0^{\infty} p(x) e^{-kx} dx$$

Please consider that the text will wrap because of the two-column format. Please ensure a balanced appearance and add a few blank lines, if required, to proceed in the new column beneath the "Introduction" heading on the left-hand side.

You are also invited to use figures and tables, for example see figure 1.

Figure captions should be in italicised *Times New Roman* 10pt font.
