

BOREALIS-MORE SCHOLARSHIP.



The **Borealis-MORE Scholarship** provides financial support to degree-seeking students who have a refugee background and who are currently completing an academic degree program at the Johannes Kepler University Linz.

What does taking part in the Borealis-MORE Scholarship mean for you?

- Receiving a scholarship amount of € 110 or € 300 per month (depending on residence status)
- Travel allowance
- Any incurred tuition fees are covered
- Signing a "Learning Agreement" (successfully completing 12 ECTS credits per semester)
- Regularly scheduled get-togethers to exchange ideas and network

Who can apply for the Borealis-MORE-Scholarship?

- Those who have a **refugee or displaced background**
- Those who hold a **letter of admission** issued by the JKU Linz **to enroll in an academic degree program**
- Those currently not receiving any financial support (study grant, Ernst Mach-Scholarship, etc.)

How can you apply?

- Send your application and documents by e-mail to: borealis-more-stipendium@jku.at between **June 27, 2022 and July 17, 2022 (=application deadline!)**.
- Application documents are available on our [homepage](#).
- Notification will be sent containing information about scheduling an interview in July or August 2022 at the JKU Linz.

What documents do we need from you?

- ✓ Completed and signed application form
- ✓ Curriculum vitae
- ✓ Motivation letter (min. ½ of an A4-size page)
- ✓ Copy of your letter of admission stating you may enroll in the degree program of your choice
- ✓ Copy of your residence card and a copy of your Kepler Card
- ✓ Copy of your academic transcripts (KUSSS) from the 2021/2022 academic year
- ✓ Verification of rejection for a state study grant (= rejected application, if available)
- ✓ Confirmation of employment (if available)
