

BOREALIS-MORE SCHOLARSHIP.



The **Borealis-MORE Scholarship** provides financial support to degree-seeking students who have a refugee background and who are currently completing an academic degree program at the Johannes Kepler University Linz.

What does taking part in the Borealis-MORE Scholarship mean for you?

- Receiving a scholarship amount of € 1,200 or € 3,600 per academic year (depending on target group/residence status)
- Travel allowance
- Any incurred tuition fees are covered
- Signing a "Learning Agreement" (successfully completing 12 ECTS credits per semester)
- Regularly scheduled get-togethers to exchange ideas and network

Who can apply for the Borealis-MORE-Scholarship?

- Those who have a **refugee background**
- Those who hold a **letter of admission** issued by the JKU Linz **to enroll in an academic degree program**
- Those currently not receiving any financial support (scholarship, study grant).

How can you apply?

- Send your application by e-mail to: more@jku.at between June 14, 2021 and July 30, 2021.
- Application documents are available on our homepage: jku.at/iwc/bo-mo-stip
- Send the application and documents to: more@jku.at before the application deadline
- Notification will be sent containing information about scheduling an interview in August 2021 at the JKU Linz

What documents do we need from you?

- A completed and signed application form
- A curriculum vitae with a photo
- A letter of intent (min. ½ of an A4-size page)
- A copy of your letter of admission stating you may enroll in the degree program of your choice
- A copy of your residence card and a copy of your Kepler Card
- A copy of your academic transcripts (KUSSS) from the 2020/2021 academic year

If you have been granted asylum, please also submit the following documents:

- Verification of rejection for a state study grant (= rejected application)
- Confirmation of employment (if available)
