

## Erasmus+ Scholarship: Internship Regulations and Info

- □ The participant is either registered in an official study program at JKU (academic status must remain active for duration of internship) or has completed a degree just prior to the internship
- □ For Bachelor's and Diploma Degree Programs:
  - Min. 2 completed semesters and a minimum of 40 successfully completed ECTS points in field of study relevant for the internship
  - StEOP completed at the JKU or at one of the *Cluster Mitte* institutions (Education)
  - Actively taken exams ("prüfungsaktiv") in the preceding two semesters

## □ For Master's Degree Program:

- Bachelor or Diploma degree has been completed at the JKU and the internship begins in the 1st semester of study: Actively taken exams ("*prüfungsaktiv*") in the preceding two semesters
- If the Bachelor or Diploma degree was completed at another institution and internship begins in the first semester: at least 8 ECTS points must have been completed
- Internships starting after the first semester: Actively taken exams ("prüfungsaktiv") in the preceding semester (8 ECTS points) / academic year (16 ECTS points) or completed a minimum of 80 ECTS in the Master's

## □ For **Doctoral Degree Program**:

- Active employment status at the JKU (or at an affiliated company): structured doctoral program
- Not actively employed at the JKU: dissertation agreement or in the first two semesters a letter of recommendation from the dissertation supervisor

## Post Graduates:

- The selection process for the internship must have taken place prior to the completion of studies and participant must not be enrolled at higher education institution during the internship
- The internship shall begin within 12 calendar months subsequent to the completion of studies/graduation
- The scholarship period is limited to 2 months (remaining time: zero grant period)
- □ Exceptions can be made in justified cases
- □ When doing an internship in the country of origin, the internship location must not be within reach from the home town (accommodation required).
- □ The host institution cannot be a European Union (EU) agency or an agency financed by the EU.
- □ The member states of the EU as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Macedonia, Norway, Serbia and Turkey are eligible to participate.
- □ It must be a full-time internship.
- □ The application for the internship scholarship must arrive at least 1 month prior to the internship.
- □ The minimum duration of the internship is 2 months. The maximum duration is 12 months (24 months if during diploma studies) per study level.
  - The scholarship period is limited to six months. Additionally, if the remuneration exceeds 200% of the scholarship rate, the scholarship period will be limited to 2 months. The remaining time will be a "zero grant" period.
- □ The traineeship must be relevant for the degree program.
- □ Special funding grants are possible for students who have children or for students with disabilities.
- □ The host country's entry and stay conditions must be followed.
