Beginning in Winter Semester 2019, the JKU launched Austria's first Bachelor's and Master's degree programs in Artificial Intelligence.

About the location: Upper Austria offers outstanding quality of life in the heart of Europe, close to the alps and in driving proximity to Vienna, Salzburg, Prague and Munich.
